



# Have you already taken the vaccination?

If you are late for the time limit of the legal vaccination, the vaccination becomes optional and will be charged. Please take the vaccination as early as possible. However, **if you do not have a vaccination register and screening questionnaire due to moving in, etc., apply for one and get vaccinated.**

◎ **Routine vaccination**◎ You can get vaccinated at the designated medical institutions located in the special 23 cities of Tokyo. ◎

## Rotavirus vaccine (Rotarix 2 times) or (Rota Teq 3 times)

- Legal age: (Rotarix) From 6 weeks to 24 weeks after birth  
(Rota Teq) From 6 weeks to 32 weeks after birth

## Hib vaccine • Pneumococcus vaccine

(3 times at intervals for the initial vaccination and once for additional vaccination)

- Legal Age: From the day before the 2nd month to the day before the 5th birthday (60 months)

## Hepatitis B vaccine

(2 times at intervals for the initial vaccination and once for additional vaccination)

- Legal Age: Until the day before the first birthday

## Combination of four vaccines (DPT-IPV) 1st Term

(3 times at intervals for the initial vaccination and once for additional vaccination)

- Legal Age: From the day before the 2nd month to the day before the child becomes 7 years and 6 months old (90 months)

## BCG (Once)

- Legal Age: Until the day before the first birthday

## Measles-Rubella (MR) combination 1st Term (Once)

- Legal Age: From the day before the 1st birthday until the day before the 2nd birthday.

**Measles and Rubella are highly infectious diseases. Do not forget to get vaccinated if you have not done yet.**

## Measles-Rubella (MR) combination 2nd Term (Once)

- Eligibility: Children between the ages of 5 and under 7 years old, and one year before entering elementary school (This program is for children who are equivalent to older children in kindergartens, nursery schools, etc.)
- Legal age: During one year prior to entering elementary school (from April 1 to March 31)

## Chicken Pox (Twice)

- Legal age: From the day before the first birthday until the day before the third birthday

## Japanese Encephalitis 1st Term

(2 times at intervals for the initial vaccination and once for additional vaccination)

- Legal age: From the day before the 6th month to the day before the child becomes 7 years and 6 months old (90 months)

The vaccination register and screening questionnaire will be sent the month after the 3rd birthday. If you wish to get vaccinated before the age of 3, you can apply separately for an individual issuance.

## Cervical Cancer (HPV) (3 times at intervals for the initial vaccination)

- Legal age: Girls from the 6th grade of elementary school to the 1st grade of high school
- Catch-up target: Females born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2007.

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- ◎ Volunteer vaccination◎ You can get vaccinated only at the designated medical institutions located in Adachi City. ◎

### **Subsidy System for Expenses of Voluntary Vaccination of Measles and Rubella**

- Contents: Those who meet all of the following conditions are eligible for a free vaccination.
  - Age is between the day before their 2nd birth date and the day before their 19th birth date.
  - Those who have never taken the routine Measles or Rubella vaccine (including the combined MR vaccine).
  - Those who have never been infected with measles or rubella.
- ※except for those who are the target of the routine vaccination this fiscal year.
- Procedures: It is necessary to have a vaccination register and screening questionnaire for Measles and Rubella vaccination. Therefore, please bring *Boshikenkotecho* to the counter shown below and take procedures of registration.( If you do not have a vaccination register and screening questionnaire, you have to pay in full.)

### **Mumps** ※Partial expense subsidy system

- Eligibility: From the day before the 1st birthday until the day before the 2nd birthday
  - ※Those born on and after April 2, 2022 are eligible for the subsidy.
- Contents: The city will bear 4,000 yen of the vaccination expenses. Please pay the difference at the medical institution.

Mumps vaccination is currently a voluntary vaccination that is not based on the Immunization Act, and there is no obligation to administer it. Please consider side effects, etc., before deciding whether to receive the vaccination.

### ◎ Others

#### **Outpatient Vaccination on Saturdays**

- Contents: Routine vaccinations except for Rotavirus, BCG, and HPV are given on the third Saturday of every month (excluding August and December).
    - ※ We provide vaccinations for children within the legal age.
    - ※ Measles may be administered with MR vaccine.
  - Site: Adachi City Medical Association Hall (3-4-4 Chuo-Honcho, Adachi-ku)
  - Hours: From 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Reception hours are from 2:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.)
    - ※ Bring the *Boshikenkotecho*, Vaccination Register and Screening Questionnaire, and thermometer, and come to the site directly with the guardian on the day.
    - ※ We do not provide treatment for children with illness.

### **Online application for Vaccination Register and Screening Questionnaire**

- ★You can now apply through online for a vaccination register and screening questionnaire. ★  
Please take advantage of this service if you have time.

To apply, you will need a document confirming your vaccination history, such as the *Boshikenkotecho*.

(It takes 1 week to 10 days from application to the sending of a vaccination register and screening questionnaire.)
