



Private Lodging Business

To all business operators who are using the city's collection service

Waste generated by private lodging businesses must be separated from household waste and properly disposed of **as commercial waste** under the responsibility of the lodging business operator.

When you use the city's collection service, please make sure to follow the rules regarding waste sorting and disposal methods, and strive to maintain the local living environment to prevent neighborhood issues such as litter or foul odors.

1 A collection commencement notification must be submitted.

If you wish to use city's collection service, please submit a collection start notification (collection site registration) to the Adachi Waste Collection Office at least two weeks before you put out your garbage. Garbage placed at a collection site without notification will not be collected. Please be sure to complete the procedure in advance.

※ When submitting the collection start notification, you will need to specify the location of the collection site. If you are setting up a new collection site, an on-site inspection will be required, so please consult with the Adachi Waste Collection Office.

2 Please follow the city's rules regarding garbage separation and other matters.

If you use the city's collection service, you must separate your garbage into combustible, noncombustible, plastic, and recyclables and store them within your accommodation or other location until their respective collection days. Also, to avoid causing inconvenience to neighbors, please attach the paid business waste disposal ticket and put it out at the collection site by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.

If you use an existing waste storage area in an apartment building or others, obtain permission to use it from the management association or other relevant entity. When storing garbage in the storage area, please attach the paid business waste disposal ticket to distinguish it from household waste.

3 Please make lodging guests well known about garbage separation and other rules.

Please make lodging guests well known about garbage separation, such as by displaying instructions in easily visible locations. Additionally, facility managers should double-check the separation status of garbage before putting them out.

4 Regarding Administrative Disposition

The city will impose administrative sanctions, such as improvement orders and public disclosure of business names, to businesses that fail to comply with city regulations, based on the "Adachi City Ordinance on Waste Disposal and Reuse."

Examples of improper processing

- ◎ Businesses that do not meet the criteria for using the city's collection service are using it.
- ◎ Using the city's collection service without a paid commercial waste disposal ticket.
- ◎ Not properly sorting waste.
- ◎ Not putting out waste at the designated time on collection day.
- ◎ Severely soiling collection sites.

How to use the city's collection service . . .

Please be sure to attach a paid commercial waste disposal ticket and put out to the registered collection site.

Types of Tickets		Fee
Extra-large 70 liters equivalent (for lightweight waste only)	5 tickets per set	3,045 yen
Large 45 liters equivalent	10 tickets per set	3,910 yen
Medium 20 liters equivalent	10 tickets per set	1,740 yen
Small 10 liters equivalent	10 tickets per set	870 yen



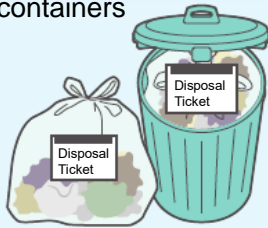
You can purchase tickets at supermarkets, convenience stores, and other stores in the city that have a "Paid Waste Disposal Ticket Handling Station" sign.

※ Please purchase Adachi City's paid waste disposal ticket. Tickets from other cities cannot be used.

Sorting/Attachment Method

※ The sorting method when disposing of waste for collection by the city is the same as for household waste.

When placing in bags or containers



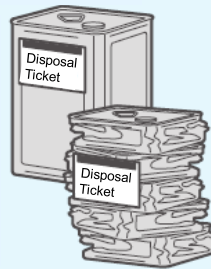
Attach a disposal ticket according to the size of the bag (or the capacity of the container)

Non-burnables

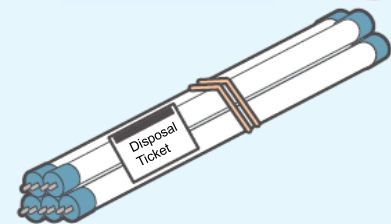
One 10-liter disposal ticket per can in its original form

Fluorescent tubes

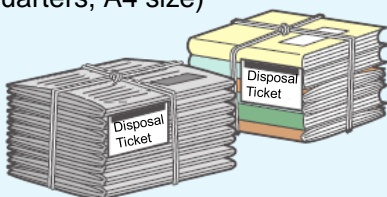
Non-burnables

(Newspapers folded into quarters, A4 size)

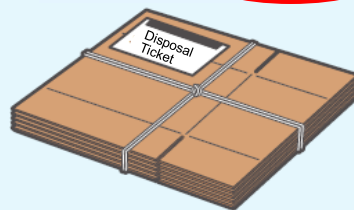
Recyclables



One 10-liter disposal ticket per 10 cm height

One 10-liter disposal ticket per two flattened boxes approx. 35 x 55 x 35 cm

Place each type of waste separately in a bag, attach a disposal ticket based on the bag size, and put it out next to the container.

✗ Items not collected by the city: bulky waste, petroleum products, paint, tires, etc.

Commission them to a waste disposal company

✓ Check before putting out the waste !

- ① Have you attached a waste disposal ticket according to the volume or size of the bag?
- ② Have you written your business name on the waste disposal ticket?
- ③ Have you separated business waste and household waste and put them in different bags?
- ④ Have you confirmed the separation of garbage and recyclables?
- ⑤ Have you placed them at the collection site by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day?

※ Please observe the designated garbage collection times to prevent crow damage and foul odors.

◆ For the separation of burnable garbage, non-burnable garbage, plastic, or recyclables, please refer to "How to Dispose of Recyclable Resources and Garbage." ◆
