▼ **Target persons and conditions to receive Japanese learning support (need to meet with all ① to ⑤ conditions below)**


- ① Must have an address in Adachi City
- ② Children/students in elementary, junior high, and high school, etc.
- ③ Have any of the Status of Residence as below:
Japanese Nationality, Permanent Resident, Spouse or Child of Japanese National, Spouse or Child of Permanent Resident, Long Term Resident, Dependent
- ④ Households that receive Public Assistance, or households that receive the Subsidy for School Expenses, or households with Residents' Tax Exempt.
- ⑤ Not using other projects, such as Adachi Habataki cram school or Adachi home study support project for school children/students who refuse to go to school.
※Dual use with Japanese language adaptive instructor or Adachi Japanese language learning room is acceptable.

▼ **How to apply**

Fill out an application form and attach the required documents (**Certificate of Recipient of Public Assistance** or **Notice of Certification of Subsidy for School Expenses** or **Residents' Tax Exemption Certificate**), and submit them to the counter of Multicultural Society Subsection. Later on, an interview will be held with the contractor for this project, followed by a decision on the student's learning course.

※Application form is distributed at the counter of Multicultural Society Subsection.

※Bring with you the residence cards of both parent/guardian and the child.
