- ① Elementary school or Junior high school students with residence registration in Adachi City
- ② Holding any of the status of residence as below:
Japanese Nationality, Permanent Resident, Spouse or Child of Japanese National, Spouse or Child of Permanent Resident, Long Term Resident, Dependent
- ③ Households that receive Public Assistance, or households that receive the Subsidy for School Expenses, or households with Residents' Tax Exempt.
- ④ Not using other program, such as Adachi Habataki cram school.
※Dual use with Japanese language adaptive instructor or Adachi Japanese language learning room is acceptable.

Fill out an application form and attach the required documents

(Certificate of Recipient of Public Assistance or Notice of Certification of Subsidy for School Expenses or Residents' Tax Exemption Certificate), and submit them to the counter of the Multicultural Society Subsection.

※Later on, an interview will be held with the contractor for this project, followed by a decision on the student's learning course.

※Bring with you the residence cards of both parent/guardian and the child.
